RIDE FEES:

A/B ride: NATRC Member \$100, Jr. \$75; Non-member \$130, Jr. \$ 110

LeD: NATRC member adult/experienced \$55, Jr. \$45, Non-member adult/experienced \$85, Non-member Jr. \$75.

(Note: \$5.00 of fees collected are for a rider fee for usage of private land)

RIIDER LIMIT: 60

TRAIL TERRAIN: Flat, Sand, Soft ground

DISTANCE: Novice & CP approx. 19 miles/day; Open approx. 27 miles/day

CAMPING: \$25.00 per person. This includes your stall. Water and electrical hook-up campsites, Bathhouses, Dogs on leash, Horses in covered stalls, Negative Coggins. Contact McCulley Farms directly for camping. **NOTE: Camp fees are PER PERSON, not per site.**

MEALS: Friday night potluck, Saturday TBD.

REGISTER: www.natrc5.org for competition. If you need assistance in registering, contact the ride manager or secretary. **NOTE:** ALL competitors and volunteers will be required to sign a COVID release waiver. Juniors will need the signature(s) of the legal parent(s) or guardian(s).

NEW COMPETITOR MEETING: After Ride Briefing

DIRECTIONS: McCulley Farm is approximately 10 miles from I-75 or 15 miles from I-10.

From I-75, take exit # 467 and turn west; you will be on State Rd. 143. Go ~10 miles and turn right into McCulley Farms

From I-10, take exit # 262 and turn north toward Lee; go through Lee. You will cross Hwy 90 (blinking red light). After Hwy 90, travel north to State Rd. 6 (there will be another blinking red light there). Turn right (east) on State Rd. 6 for 5 miles. Turn left (north) on 143 for 1 ½ miles. McCulley Farms will be on the left hand side.
