The Saturday, May 4, Clinic will cover the philosophy and teachings of competitive distance riding and how to build an effective partnership with your horse. Maneuvers, manners, conditioning, safety and horsemanship are some of the essential fundamentals covered. Please bring lunch as clinic lasts all day.

The **OFFICIAL LEISURE RIDE held Sunday, May 5**, will help implement what you've worked on during the clinic. Patty Lucas will be our Judge and Marsha Howard is our Trail Master. Both do a great job!!!

For those participating **SATURDAY OR BOTH DAYS**, there will be a **one-time registration** held on **Saturday at 9 a.m.** Negative Coggins will be required.

For those completing **Sunday, May 5, only**, Registration will be **Sunday at 9:00 a.m.** Actual Ride will begin at around 10:00. Ride should last 3 – 3 ½ hours with awards over hopefully by 4 p.m.

Clinic includes in-hand/groundwork and in saddle. Bring lunge rope/chair if you have.
Leisure Ride - 8-10 miles/up to 5 obstacles. Hoof protection, boots or shoes recommended.
