**Camping:** Water and electrical hook-up campsites, Cabins, Bathhouse, NO Stalls, Dogs on leash, Negative Coggins Required. All camping and activities will be held in the Equine/Overflow camp site which is first come first serve. If you would like a “guaranteed camp site” contact Alabama State Parks @ 1-800-ALA-PARK to reserve your campsite in Section E. (Horse Camping available there beginning November) These reservations can be transferred to the Equine camping area at check-in. Horses are not allowed to walk between camping areas except on trails. Therefore, an Equine taxi will be made available if needed during check-in/out and time in/out.

**Distance and Trail Terrain:** Moderate trails through ridges and bottoms of mixed hardwood, pines and ferns along streams and beautiful Lake Martin. Some gravel. Boots or shoes are recommended. Novice & CP approx. 15 miles/day; Open approx 25 miles/day

**DIRECTIONS:** From Mobile or Atlanta via I-85, take exit 58 (Gateway Dr, signs for Opelika/Robert Trent Jones Golf Trail). Turn onto Hwy 280 West and travel for 35.6 miles. Turn left onto Co Rd. 21/Coven Abbett Hwy. In 4.2 miles, the entrance to Wind Creek will be on your left.

From Atlanta via I-20 West, take exit 199 to AL-9 South/Almon St. toward Heflin. Stay on AL-9 S for ~58 miles. Turn left to merge on to US-280 East. Turn right onto Co Rd. 21/Coven Abbett Hwy. In 4.2 miles, the entrance to Wind Creek will be on your left.

From Birmingham via Hwy 280 East, Turn right onto Co Rd. 21/Coven Abbett Hwy. In 4.2 miles, entrance to Wind Creek will be on your left.
